STRONGSVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT CITIZEN RIDE-ALONG PROGRAM

NOTICE OF CONFIDENTIALITY OF DEPARTMENT INFORMATION

- 1. Citizen ride-alongs shall not disclose or allow access to material, documents or information contained in or obtained from Local, State, Federal law enforcement databases or sources, or any other agency of Local, State or Federal government, unless such disclosure or access is authorized by law.
- 2. Citizen ride-alongs shall not use any information derived from Strongsville Police Department sources or records for personal gain or use, except as authorized by law or department policies and procedures.
- 3. Citizen ride-alongs shall not permit any person to receive information connected with the operations of the Strongsville Police Department without permission of the Police Chief or as otherwise provided by law or departmental policies and procedures.
- 4. Citizen ride-alongs shall not disclose to anyone the fact or the nature of any investigation except as provided by law or department policies and procedures.
- 5. Citizen ride-alongs shall not give any unauthorized person any information concerning the location of records, weapons, ammunition, the number of officers on duty, shift assignment, patrol beat areas, or other operational matter.
- 6. Serving the public provides each of us with a great responsibility. Consequently, there can be no compromise in the requirement for all citizen ride-alongs to follow the Strongsville Police Department policies and procedures on records and information and this "Notice of Confidentiality of Department Information." Any violations of said requirements shall subject citizen ride-alongs to possible civil and criminal penalties.

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RULES OF CONDUCT

Citizen Ride-Along Responsibilities

- 1. Observers should be aware that the police officer has a duty to perform and that the observer should not, in any way, interfere with the carrying out of that duty. For example, questions should not be asked while the officer is involved in activity.
- 2. No weapons, such as firearms, batons, O.C. spray, etc., will be carried by a ride-along participant unless specifically approved in advance by the Chief of Police or his designee.
- 3. Observers are encouraged to ask questions, but should not criticize an officer's actions.
- 4. Riders must show respect to any and all persons encountered during the ride, and will refrain from the use of abusive or profane language.
- 5. Riders will not voice remarks to complainants, witnesses, victims, or suspects, or behave in any manner that would tend to provoke or escalate tension.
- 6. No ride-along will convey the impression that they are police officers or act as a police agent in any manner while participating in this program (i.e., interviewing, physical confrontations, etc.).
- 7. In the event of a violent incident, observers should not leave the patrol car and should leave any confrontation to the police officer, unless instructed by the police officer.
- 8. Observers are not allowed to bring tape recorders or cameras in the patrol car unless approved in advance by the Chief of Police or his designee.
- 9. Riders must not leave the patrol car during police action (e.g. during a traffic stop, while answering a call, etc.) unless directed by the police officer.
- 10. Observers shall not engage in any foot pursuit or the apprehension and/or arrest of any individual.
- 11. Observers should follow all instructions of the police officer.
- 12. Observers are to be suitably dressed in a collared shirt, blouse or jacket, slacks and shoes. Sandals, t-shirts, tank tops, shorts and ripped or torn blue jeans are not permitted. Hats and ball caps will not be worn in the police vehicle.
- 13. Observers will not use alcoholic beverages prior to or during the ride.
